General information as follows:

- 1. Key blank references are for the profile only, using one of the more well-known blank numbers. This list does not include all variations of different head shapes, lengths, or transponders, the main object is to identify which key profile enters the lock.
- 2. We supply coded or uncoded according to what is available to us from the manufacturer. All coded cylinders can be disassembled for rekeying, using the tumblers and keying kits listed.
- 3. Identify which tumblers and keying kits to use according to the separate chart organized by the key blank numbers.

Ignition Lock Housing Cross Reference

Honda and Acura ignition locks have a casting number on the outside of the housing. Use this chart to identify the replacement cylinders that are available to make necessary repairs. If you need to repair a lock without knowing the exact year and model vehicle that it came from, find the casting number on the housing and check this chart for available service parts. Also there are some years and models for which we do not have verified information about which ignition lock is used. For those check this list for the casting number to determine if any service parts are available.

This chart covers only casting numbers for which we have verified information. The year and model application chart and the housing cross reference chart will be updated as verified information becomes available.

Most of these housings will also have a number that begins with "HL" which is not the casting number that you need to use this chart. All known important casting numbers begin with S or T.

SPECIAL NOTE ABOUT 1997 ACURA CL IGNITION LOCKS:

There is a variation in the end of the plug of the locks that were installed on the car when it was built. We know of no way to know which design is used without disassembling the old lock to see what is there. Depending upon which design is used you may be able to rebuild the old lock using our cylinder C-19-121, or you may have to use our C-19-239 complete lock and housing. See the pictures below to determine what you need.

If the end of the plug of the old lock looks like the one in the picture below our C-19-121 will not work, you must use the C-19-239. Replacement cylinders with the end of the plug shaped like this one are not available.



If the end of the plug of the old lock looks like the one in the picture below, either C-19-121 or C-19-239 will work.
